### TEAM REPORTS

**Adult Education:** (S. Willerton). “Chewin on the Word” Class started 9/18. Baptism class started and will be held for four weeks. There were three Mentors working with Carson, Aiden and Katie (Kathy Howard, Tom Howard and Mary Jane Hickey). Thank you for your participation! Baptism has been moved to Oct 22. It will also be Youth Sunday. Oct 15 will still be XPLORESidents visit and then Café Brunch after service. Sherry will hold the first Disciples History Class, tomorrow night, Wednesday, Sept 20 at 6:30p.m.

**Children/Youth Education:** (J. Akins absent) Sherry mentioned that the Children’s Choir started up on 9/17, at 8:30a.m. with Sherry. Koffee & Kids – Carla mentioned that Jana is wanting to reach out to connect with the community. Suggestions made to check out Religious Sections online that can be updated, family radio, etc. Sherry will work on the online portion. Jane will put an update under K&K to say to phone Jana if you expressed an interest in helping with this program.

**Deacons:** (J. Hart). I was very pleased with the Youth (Aiden and Sierra Presuhn) this past Sunday, lighting the candles and reading the Call to Worship. Sierra was awesome in volunteering to do the reading. They did an excellent job! We will need to make sure Deacons unplug the coffee pot each week. Jane will make a sign reminding them of this.

**Elders:** (T. Howard). Tom Howard is Elder for the month of October. This Sunday is Sherry’s Installation and Tom and Kathy will be the Elders for that service. Joyce and Wayne are the Deacons for this service as well.

**Finance:** (W. Anderson) Report Attached. Pat Williams has stepped down as Treasurer, effective immediately. Donna Cecchi will start as temporary Treasurer effective in October. Wayne explained his attached report and August month end from Pat. End spendable funds is \$1200.00. Wayne requested budgets from teams. Rummage Sale is Oct. 14<sup>th</sup>, including the Grill as well as Bake Sale. We will tear down chairs from the rummage sale on Oct. 14<sup>th</sup> and set up tables and chairs for the Café brunch and the service will be held with this setup.

Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> will first be Trevor Beecham's Memorial Service at 2:00pm with light refreshments. At 6:00p.m. will be our Oktoberfest with Brats, Buns, sauerkraut and beans. Bring your own favorite refreshments for the event.

**Property:** (T. Howard). Tom reported that the jobs on his TO DO list have been completed. Tom will check the A/C programmed settings to make sure the system does not stay on when not needed. The boy scout troop that meets at our church has grown and is strong, with Bryce now being an adult and will start working with the troop more. There are more kids attending this troop as other troops have closed their doors. The new Head Troop Lead is Barry Messing, and Weldon is now Assistant.
