EVALUATION & COMMENTS:

- Wall of Prayer – More are participating but for the next 3 Sundays, Jess will be asked to play longer during “moment of silence” and communion to allow everyone time to go to the Wall and write their prayers.
- Ash Wednesday – Although it was very rainy that day during Ashes to Go, there was still very good attendance both morning and afternoon. Evening service was great with usual attendance.
- Youth: Sherry is trying to meet with Rob Presuhn to coordinate Aiden and Sierra’s participation again in lighting the candles, etc.

MINISTER’S UPDATE & NEW BUSINESS:

- Healing Service: March 18: Xplor resident will participate in the Call to Worship and possibly more? At the end of the sermon, the Healing Service portion will begin with two stations at the back of the church. Two chairs will be needed and Sherry has the anointing oil. At least one Elder will be at each chair. Sherry will speak with Jess about playing a bit longer during that part of the service.
- March 25: Palm Sunday
 - Palms will be delivered to Anderson’s house and Wayne will spread them to dry in the Modular.
 - Joan and other volunteers will hand out the palms as people arrive.
 - All will process into the sanctuary, singing and waving palms after joining in the Call to Worship.
 - After partaking communion by intinction, each person will place their palm in the area of most meaning for them.
 - After service, the sanctuary chairs will be moved to the sides of the room and tables set up in the form of a cross for Maundy Thursday.
 - Potluck lunch will be organized by Nurture Team.
- March 29: Maundy Thursday: 6 p.m. supper; 7 p.m. service
 - Joan has offered to purchase the Naan bread needed for communion.
 - Tables will be arranged in shape of a cross and tables will be covered on Monday, March 26. Joan, Judy, Wayne and possibly Jennifer will work on that.

March 29: 4:30 p.m.: set tables and prepare communion which will be placed on each table between supper and service.

Jess has another commitment so will not be able to attend and play the piano. Sherry will find alternatives.

Wayne will dim the lights for the service and especially for Sherry's drama. Sherry will direct him on what to do.

Good Friday Service: 2:30 p.m. in the Memorial Garden. Carol has offered to sing Via Dolorosa.

Either before or after the service, Joan will direct the clean up from Maundy Thursday service, set up the chairs in the sanctuary and change the banners and cloths (white) for Easter. Judy and Wayne will help.
